The Holy Family Parents and Friends (P&F) Association is a group of volunteers, made up of parents, grandparents or carers, that work closely with the school leaders to achieve common goals for our children's education

These are great events that the children really look forward to and you can get involved by volunteering to assist with planning or coordinating the running any of these events for the school community.
